- To allow video or digital pictures of my athlete participating in Saint Louis Synergy - MEFSC events to be used for promotional purposes – such as, on the web site, in a brochure, on a promotional video, etc.
- To respect the decisions of the coach. The coach is a hired professional. I will support and respect her decisions and demonstrate this to my child.
- To support the coach in carrying out her decisions
- To understand that being a member of a team is different than being a singles skater and help my child to understand and appreciate those differences.
- To understand some individual decision-making authority will be yielded in the interest of the team
- To thoughtfully and carefully complete the coach's evaluation form at the end of the year
- To commit to enrolling my skater in the appropriate Synchro lessons offered specifically for my synchro team at the Webster Rink.
- To commit to providing private lessons for my athlete
- To commit to passing the Moves in the Field test as it is required for my skater's team and to prepare for the future by continuing to work on the Moves in the Field required by the team above my skater.
